Fever, chills • Shortness of breath • Sore throat • Loss of taste or smell •

vomiting or diarrhea • Fatigue • Muscle or body aches



**REGARDLESS of vaccination status, individual must stay home if exhibiting
symptoms or if symptoms start in school, they must return home.
Contact health care provider.**



**Alternate
diagnosis**

Individual can
return to school
with a note
signed by their
health care
provider
explaining the
alternate
diagnosis.



**COVID-19
test result is
negative:**

Individuals can
return to school
if symptoms are
improving, and
they are fever-
free for 24 hours
without fever
reducing
medication.

They must
provide a copy of
the negative test
result or a note
from their health
care provider
indicating the
negative result.



**COVID-19
test result
is positive:**

Individual is
placed in
isolation by
SCHD

Individual can
return to
school after
being released
from Isolation
by SCHD.



**No test/No
alternate
diagnosis:**

Individual may
return to school
after at least 10
days have passed
since date of first
symptoms

AND

Individual's
symptoms are
improving

AND

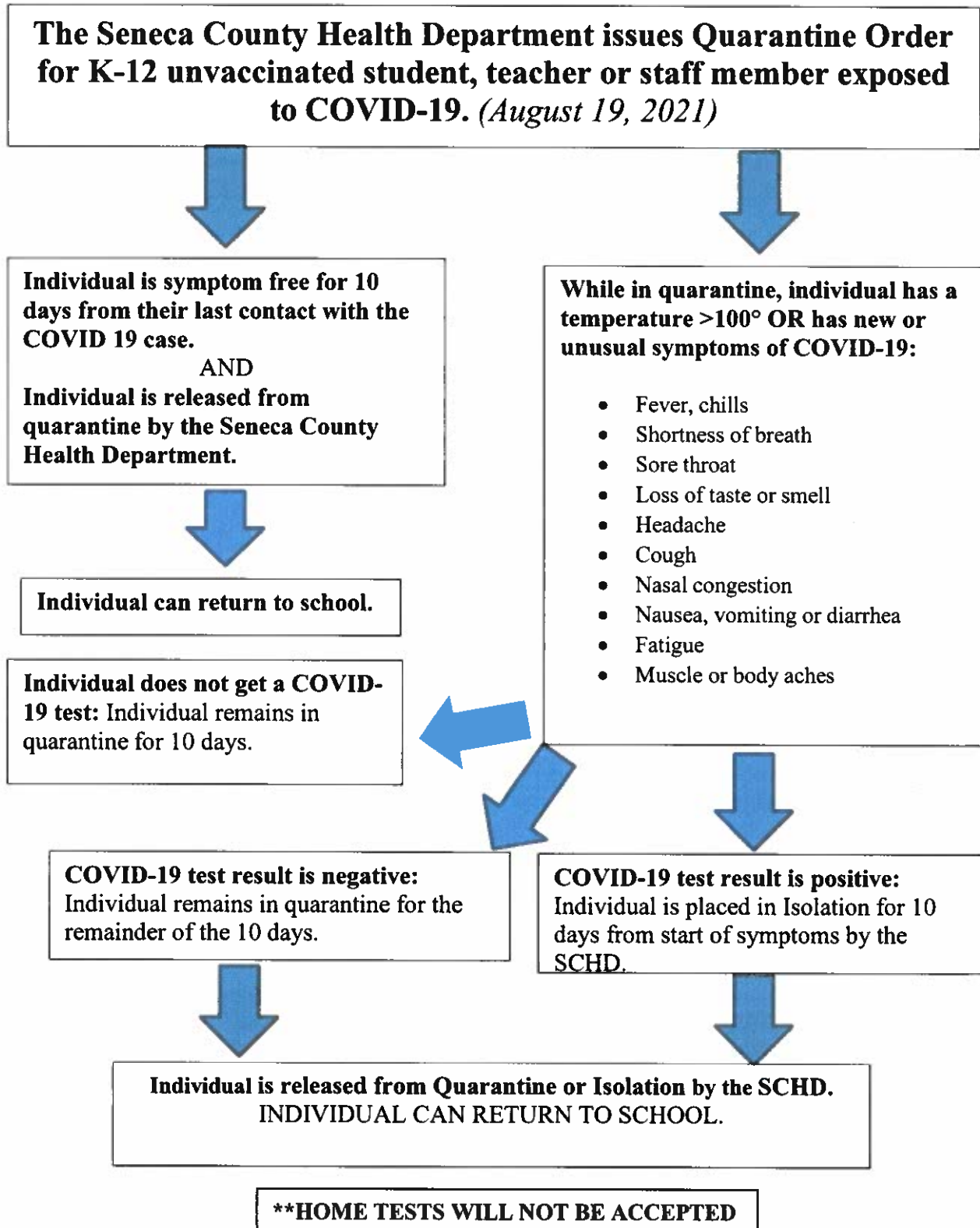
Individual is

medicines.

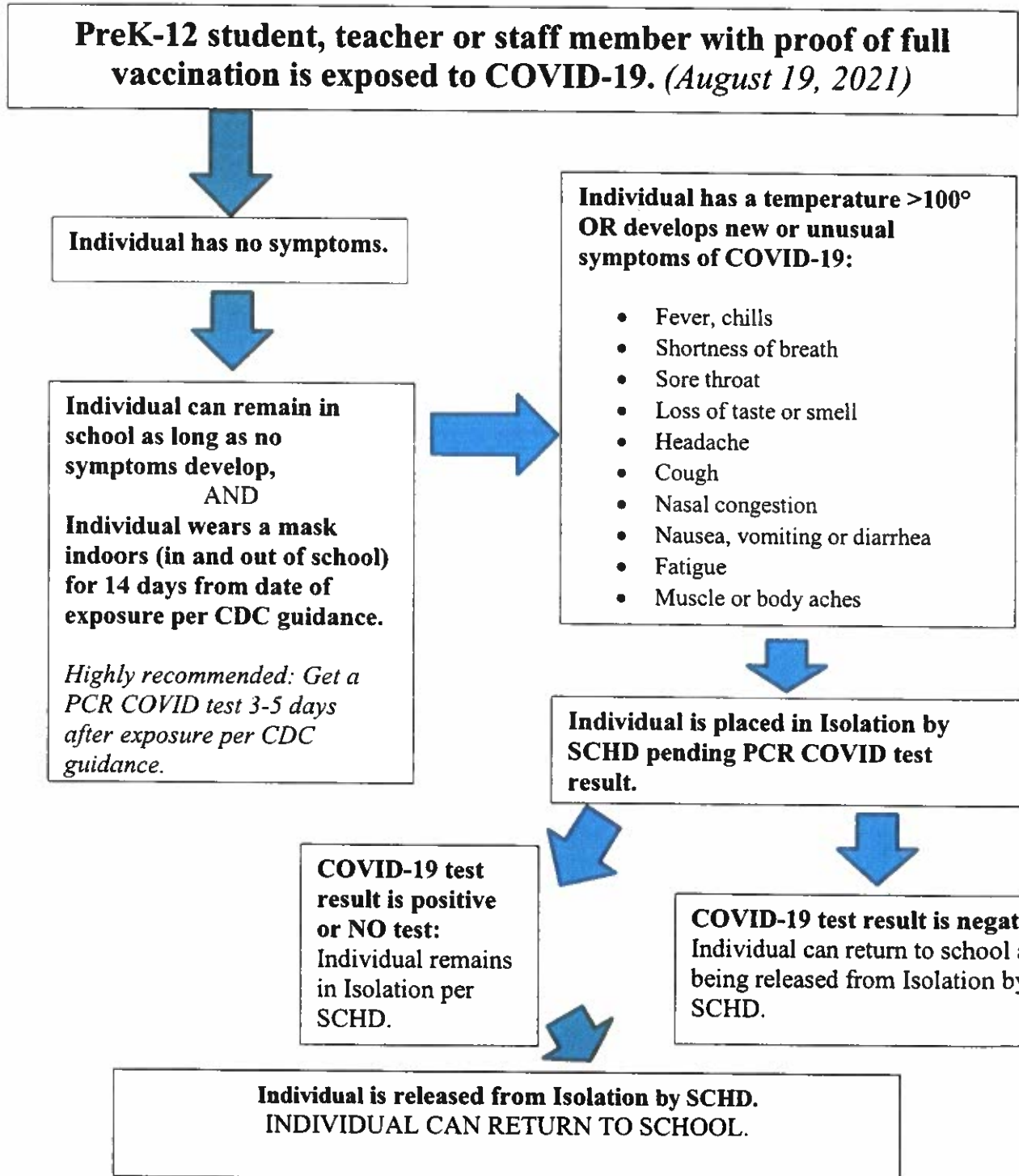
