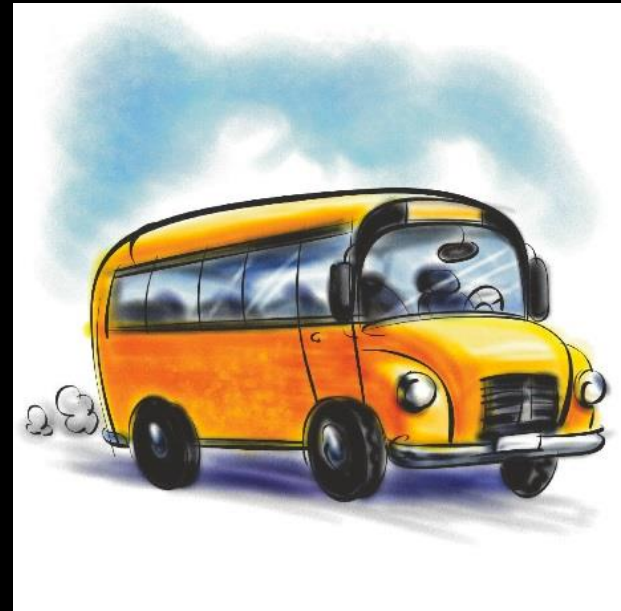


Annual Title I Meeting

Elementary and Secondary Education Act

Title 1 Funds are given to schools based on the percentage of poverty in the area where the school is located.



Information about Title I

- Being a Title I school means receiving federal funding (Title I dollars) to supplement the school's existing programs. These dollars are used for:
 - Identifying students experiencing academic difficulties and providing timely assistance to help these student's meet the State's challenging content standards.
 - Purchasing supplemental staff/programs/materials/supplies
 - Conducting Parental Involvement meetings/trainings/activities
 - Recruiting/Hiring/Retaining Highly Qualified Teachers

Title I Requirements

- Schools must comply with Federal and State laws regarding Title I
- Federal funds must be used for **supplementary educational programs and materials**
- Programs and materials must support **student progress**

Title I School-Wide Program at Waterloo CSD

Program funds provide:

- Student skill-based interventions provided by **Reading & Math Specialists**
- Student instructional support during the school day with **"highly qualified"** teachers and para-professionals
- Increasing parent involvement

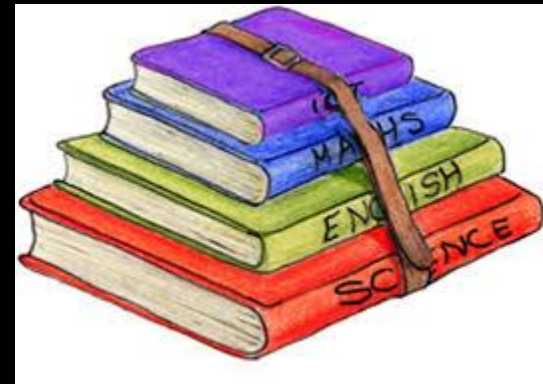

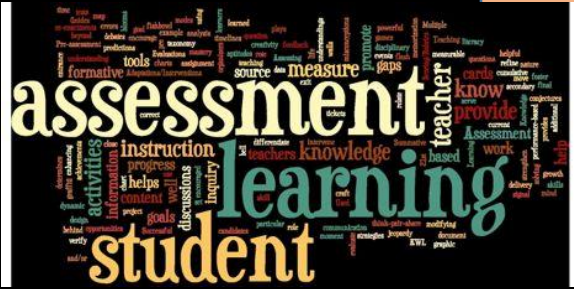
Curriculum
