

ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY/REGULATIONS FOR STUDENTS

(*applicable to use of all District electronic resources both on and off campus, including, but not limited to computers, equipment, electronic devices, communication platforms and applications, internet, websites, emails, social media)

As a student/parent of Waterloo Central School District, I agree that I will:

- Read, be familiar with and adhere to applicable Board of Education policies and rules related to the use of the District's electronic resources (available at <https://www.waterloocsd.org/>), including, but not limited to:
 - Policy No. 7315 ("Student Use of Computerized Information Resources")
 - The District's Code of Conduct
- Be responsible and exercise care when using the District's electronic resources, including, but not limited to, computer equipment, devices, files and passwords.
- Promptly notify a teacher or administrator of potential security problems, loss, theft or damage.
- Maintain confidentiality and not access, transmit or share confidential information related to any other person.
- Follow acceptable etiquette, which includes: being polite, being a role model and using appropriate language.

As a student/parent of Waterloo Central School District, I agree that I will not:

- Access, use, send, share or modify electronic resources, information or data that I do not have District authorization to access, use, send, share or modify.
- Use any District electronic resource to commit any illegal act.
- Access, transmit, store or post any inappropriate item such as pornographic or obscene material, or material that is profane, lewd, rude, inflammatory, or material that contains threatening or disrespectful language.
- Access, use, post, store or send potentially damaging, dangerous or disruptive material.
- Engage in harassment or discrimination.
- Transmit false or defamatory information.
- Commit plagiarism.
- Participate in malicious activities or downloading, transmitting or otherwise inappropriately using copyrighted material.
- Solicit personal information with the intent of using it to cause emotional or physical harm.
- Download or install unauthorized software programs or content.
- Utilize another person's password to access the District's electronic resources.
- Share my password with any other person.
- Utilize the District's electronic resources in any manner that could cause harm to students.

I understand that my use of the District's electronic resources may be subject to monitoring at any time, without my knowledge and/or permission. I understand that I have no expectation of privacy related to my use of the District's electronic resources.

I understand and agree that unauthorized use of the District's electronic resources may lead to discipline and termination of my right to access the District's electronic resources, as well as civil and/or criminal penalties.
